SECTION 1: SOLICITATION INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

DESCRIPTION OF ENTITY

Stichting Mayday Rescue Foundation is a not-for-profit foundation registered and headquartered in Amsterdam with projects running in Europe, the Middle East and Africa. Mayday's mission is to save lives and strengthen communities in areas of the world that are entering, enduring or emerging from conflict and natural disasters. This is achieved by building partnerships with grassroot emergency response groups at the local, regional and national levels.

PURPOSE

Mayday Rescue seeks to purchase a total of 13 vehicles on behalf of a partner organisation located in the Middle East. Full details of our requirement can be found in Annex 1 to this document.

GENERAL INFORMATION

These general information will not form part the Contract. They are intended solely to aid suppliers in the preparation of their proposals. **Read and follow these instructions carefully.**

- 1. The schedule of events and information provided in **SOLICITATION DATA** of this document must be adhered to.
- 2. Mayday Rescue will reject any bids that do not serve the best interest of Mayday, their benefactors or beneficiaries for, but not limited to the following reasons:
- Proposals received after the submission deadline.
- Proposals containing irregularities.
- Proposals that do not adhere to the instructions contained herein.
- Unbalanced values.
- Unethical conduct.
- Reason for believing collusion exists amongst suppliers and/or other stakeholders.
- The Supplier having any form of unresolved dispute with Mayday Rescue.
- Lack of competency revealed by our own findings or those of an agency.
- 3. General correspondence is to be addressed to the procurement officer listed in Section 1 of this document. Actual bids must be sent to procurement@maydayrescue.org.
- 4. Issuance of this document, your preparation and subsequent evaluation shall not commit Mayday Rescue to award contract to any supplier. Furthermore, in no event shall choosing a specific supplier for further negotiations be construed to create any legal obligations on the part of Mayday Rescue.
- 5. This document is provided for the exclusive use of your company and shall not be made available to other parties without consent being granted by Mayday Rescue. Both you and Mayday Rescue acknowledge that they may come in contact with non-public information,

which is considered confidential or proprietary to the other (including this document). Each party agrees not to use such information for its own benefit or allow it to be released to, or used by others.

COST AND FEES

All costs arising from preparation of bids, meetings, presentations or provision of samples shall be borne by the bidder regardless on the outcome of the tender process.

AMENDMENTS TO SOLICITATION DOCUMENTS

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, Mayday may modify the requirements listed within this document. All bidders will be notified of any such changes.

LANGUAGE OF BIDS

Bids and correspondence relating to this tender must be submitted in English. The bidder is responsible for the accuracy and contents of any documents that are translated.

PAYMENT AND CURRENCY

- All prices must be quoted in the currency listed within SOLICITATION DATA of this
 document.
- All payment will be made in this currency and no adjustments will be made for fluctuations in currency.
- Terms of payment should be expressed in each bid you submit to Mayday. Final payment terms will be discussed and agreed upon prior to the award of contract being made.

DELIVERY

All vehicles provided by suppliers based in Turkey or elsewhere must deliver the vehicles Zero Zone – the Syrian border crossing point, Reyhanlı, Civegözü Hatay or Öncüpınar Kilis, DAP Status.

Technical Proposal:

- Should clearly & precisely address theoretical and practical aspects that the Supplier has considered and will employ to carry out the Purpose of this RFP
- The Technical Proposal is the opportunity for the supplier to demonstrate that the firm is "technically capable" of providing the requested work, and should demonstrate the supplier's understanding of and capabilities to carry out the work, and address the key issues described in the Evaluation Criteria.
- If an supplier submits a proposal that fails to respond to the majority of the information requested in this RFP, as outlined specifically in the statement of work and the evaluation criteria, the supplier's proposal will be automatically disqualified.
- The supplier must fully complete the forms related to the LOT he wants to bid on and submitted along with the technical proposal.
- You can submit more than one bid in each Lot if you have different types of vehicles that meet our requirements.

For example, you have four Isuzu firefighting trucks and six Hyundai firefighting trucks in stock. You submit two bid forms for Lot 3, in one you offer to sell Mayday all four Isuzus trucks, and in the other, you offer all six Hyundai's. Mayday decides to purchase four Isuzu and three Hyundai trucks from you.

The Cost/Business Proposal:

must be submitted separately from the technical proposal and will primarily indicate the cost for performing the work specified in this RFP

Failure to comply with any of the above points will result in the Supplier being considered "unresponsive" and the proposal may be rejected.

If an Supplier provides insufficient information in their technical and/or cost proposal, Mayday Rescue reserves the right to request additional information, or to request a revised proposal from the supplier, if necessary.

Mayday Rescue reserves the right to make multiple awards, or no award under this RFP.

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

The award will be made to the supplier whose offer presents the Best Value: the optimal combination of technical merits and reasonable cost. Proposals will be scored on technical factors first and then on Cost factors
